Describe how the conditions for Temporary Occupancy are met:

- 1. Duration must be temporary, i.e., less than the time needed for construction of the project, and there should be no change in ownership of the land.**

Agreed. The duration will be temporary and less than the time needed to reconstruct Bernard Drive. There will be no change in land ownership.

- 2. Scope of the work must be minor, i.e., both the nature and the magnitude of the changes of the Section 4 (f) property are minimal.**

Agreed. The existing bike path and culvert will be replaced with no changes proposed in bike path or roadway width or function.

- 3. There are no anticipated permanent adverse physical impacts, nor will there be interference with the protected activities, features, or attributes of the property, on either a temporary or permanent basis.**

Agreed. No changes to the nature, function, or attributes of the BGPLD property are proposed.

- 4. The land being used must be fully restored, i.e., the property must be returned to a condition which is at least as good as that which existed prior to the project.**


Agreed. All disturbed land areas will be restored.

- 5. There must be documented agreement of the official(s) with jurisdiction over the section 4(f) resource regarding the above conditions.**

Based upon this analysis this project's temporary occupancy of the section 4(f) resource described above satisfies the conditions set forth in 23 CFR 771.13(d) and is so minimal as to not constitute a use within the meaning of Section 4(f). Approval of this temporary occupancy evaluation is requested.
